



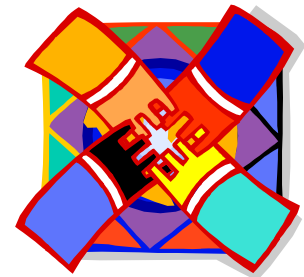
Guidelines for CITD Grant Money for International Projects

The District has been awarded a grant through the Center for International Trade Development (CITD). This grant can fund full-time faculty and staff to attend workshops or travel in order to internationalize the curriculum, pursue study abroad opportunities, or explore other international development options.

The grant objectives give faculty the opportunity to set new learning objectives for curriculum, share resources, increase industry skills and knowledge, and internationalize curriculum. Full-time faculty and staff can travel overseas in order to obtain information, if necessary.
